## From Alex Galbraith..... 'A joyful and eternal future'

When Mary Magdalene went to the tomb early in the morning of the first day of the week, she saw Jesus through her tears. In the uncertain light of dawn and with the water in her eyes, she did not recognize him. It was not surprising. The light was dim, her eyes were wet and she was not expecting to see him.

It often feels like that with us. With all the horrible things going on in the world; and closer to home: churches closing or changing, fewer people worshipping, lay people and ministers struggling, and illness and difficulties with relationships, and old age and bereavement, the light of the present and the future does seem uncertain, and we shed tears, sometimes inwardly, but sometimes real tears from our eyes.

We find it hard to recognize Jesus or to receive his comfort and help. It was when he spoke to her, when he said her name, that Mary Magdalene knew him and her tears of sorrow became tears of joy. When we hear the word of god in our prayers, in our worship or in the bible, when we receive the love and support of fellow Christians, the dim light grows brighter, and our expectations of Jesus, our trust in him, our recognition of him, grows less uncertain. As we celebrate Easter, we can have confidence in him for a joyful and eternal future, even though we now see him often through our tears.

27 years ago this month, I was Recognized and Regarded as a Methodist minister for the first time; more recently I have been authorized to serve as a Methodist Minister. I have loved this time, particularly taking services in the different churches in the circuit, meeting you, being welcomed by you and worshipping with you. I have had some good colleagues, Marie-Anne best of all. Thank you so much for your love and fellowship, which have meant a great deal to me.

Many of you will know that I have terminal cancer and I appreciate your prayers. I may be close to the end of my time as a Methodist Minister, but I am not quite finished yet.
